
FROM SANGHYEON'S DESK

Schweitzer and Hélène

Albert Schweitzer grew up in a privileged environment, receiving the best education money could offer. Yet even as a child, he showed a remarkable sensitivity to others. When his parents tried to dress him in fine clothes, he would protest, saying, "Others can't afford to dress like this—how can I wear it?" This deep empathy shaped his entire life.

As a young man, Schweitzer learned of the suffering in Africa caused by the lack of medical care. He could not simply ignore what he now saw as a call from God. So, already accomplished as a theologian and musician, he chose to begin medical school—determined to spend the rest of his life serving those in need.

But then, he fell in love. Her



name was Hélène. Those around him assumed he would abandon his plans for Africa to stay by her side. Schweitzer wrestled deeply with this inner conflict. One day, he visited Hélène and spoke with quiet determination: "I am someone who must go to Africa." Moved by his conviction and love, Hélène replied, "If I become a nurse, then I can help you in real, practical ways, can't I?" She went on to study nursing, and after they married, they journeyed to Africa together—where they spent the rest of their lives offering devoted, compassionate care.

True love does not insist on being understood first; it seeks to understand the other. It does not aim to change the other, but to accept and honour them. Every love that shines with true beauty is marked by commitment, sacrifice, and deep consideration.

As we enter a new month, may we grow in that kind of love—serving and caring for those around us with the same spirit of humility and devotion. May our homes, churches, and communities be shaped by love that is self-giving and faithful.

"Now which of these three would you say was a neighbour to the man who was attacked by bandits?" Jesus asked. The man replied, "The one who showed him mercy." Then Jesus said, "Yes, now go and do the same." (Luke 10:36-37, NLT)

<u>Wild Geese</u> Wild Geese will be held at Jacobs' house on Friday 29th August.



- The ongoing humanitarian crisis in Gaza as aid agencies warn that relief supplies have been nearly exhausted.
